DSRSD published its 2019 Annual Water Quality Report in a web-friendly PDF format that can be printed on standard. The report was posted www.dsrsd.com/water-quality-report on the DSRSD website on April 29, 2020, along with a home page feature that linked directly to it. The report is available year-round in the District's website library under "Environmental Permits and Monitoring Reports." A "Water Quality" webpage also links to the report.

Approximately 17,000 customers received the direct URL via a bill insert in their May, June or July water bills.

The required notices were translated into Spanish and Chinese (based on 2010 U.S. Census data indicating more than 1,000 non-English-speaking residents of Chinese descent in the DSRSD water service area) and featured prominently on the report, bill insert, and emailed notices.

To reach non-bill-paying water consumers, between May 15 and May 20, 2020, DSRSD mailed or delivered a gummed pad of 50 bill inserts, suitable for tabletops and bulletin boards, to 35 master-metered multi- family complexes. Senior centers and public libraries remain closed due to COVID 19, so we are unable to use these as a distribution channel as we normally would. DSRSD also posted notice of the report's availability via the social media outlet, Nextdoor.com, Facebook and Twitter.
