SNBC-CCR-2024

Drinking Water Source Assessment Information:

A copy of the Drinking Water Source Assessment (DWSA) is available in the Plant Utilities office at Sierra Nevada Brewing Co. and at the Butte County Department of Public Health. The Assessment was completed by SNBC staff on 11/10/2016. The zones of influence were calculated according to Table 1 for a porous media aquifer and a design pumping rate of 600 gpm. The DWSA includes a well data sheet and a Potential Contaminating Activities (PCA) checklist. Numerous PCAs were identified within all three zones, and details are available in the DWSA.

Time and Place of Regularly Scheduled Board Meetings for Public Participation:

Since the system is wholly owned by and operated for Sierra Nevada Brewing Co., no separate board exists for the management of the water system. The system is managed by the Plant Utilities department under the direction of the Director of Plant Operations. Customers who desire participation in decisions that may affect the quality of the water may contact the department directly.
