

Pickleball Courts Grand Opening at Palomares Park

Pickleball, a combination of tennis (net), ping-pong (paddle), and badminton (size of court) is America's fastest growing sport for the fifth consecutive year in a row. ESPN recently signed a deal with the Association of pickleball to broadcast and stream live coverage of events. The growth has also attracted interest from a variety of investors and athletes, including NBA players LeBron James, Kevin Love, and Draymond Green, who are part of an ownership group for the Major League Pickleball. The league has expanded to 24 teams and has set a goal for the sport to reach 40 million players by 2030.

Historically, there were no pickleball courts in Pomona. The City has received several requests from the public to add such courts, knowing that there are pickleball courts in neighboring cities. Palomares Park, a 17-acre park with various amenities such as a community center (Facilities/Rental office/Staff offices), senior center, teen center, basketball courts, and baseball/softball fields, is an excellent site to accommodate the City's first pickleball courts. The four (4) existing tennis courts at the North end of Palomares Park were resurfaced and restriped to create 16 pickleball courts, as this would continue to allow tennis play. Due to the smaller dimension requirements of a standard pickleball court (20' x 44') for both singles and doubles, installing hybrid tennis/pickleball courts provides the ability for one (1) tennis court to accommodate up to four (4) pickleball courts. While the maximum number of people playing tennis on one court is four players playing doubles, the maximum number of people playing pickleball, using the same space, can be up to 16 players on four courts, which further activates positive activities in the park and creates opportunities for leagues, games, and tournaments.

In creating a pilot program for pickleball, recreational activities will be integrated into existing youth, teen, and senior programming, including opportunities for inter-generational play. Outdoor & Active, the Pomona Unified School District (PUSD) funded program administered by City staff,

offers youth ages 4-17 opportunities to participate in youth sports, recreation games, and nature based activities. La Casita Teen Center, located at Palomares Park, offers youth ages 13-17 a place to do homework, play billiards, video games, and play sports. The Senior Program offers a senior meals program, nutrition classes, computer classes, and health/fitness classes for adults 60+. Pickle ball can be incorporated at all of these levels.
