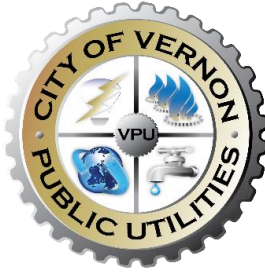

The subject Notice also provided information on whom to contact in the event a hard copy is desired. This information was provided in both English and Spanish. **This Notice contains instructions for you to obtain important information about your drinking water.**

The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) requires that the City of Vernon (City) provide you with an Annual Water Quality Report. The purpose of the Annual Water Quality Report is to raise customers' awareness of the quality of their drinking water, where their drinking water comes from, what it takes to deliver water to their homes, and the importance of protecting drinking water resources.

In recent years, the City has mailed a printed copy of the Annual Water Quality Report to comply with the SDWA. On February 13, 2013, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) expanded its interpretation of the Safe Drinking Water Act to allow for electronic delivery of the Annual Water Quality Report. The electronic delivery method will allow the City of Vernon to reduce the consumption of paper, and minimize potential printing and mailing costs.

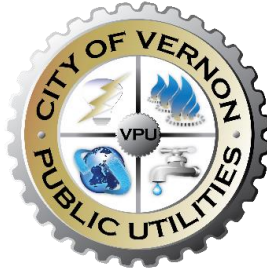

El método de entrega electrónica permitirá a la Ciudad de Vernon reducir el consumo de papel y minimizar los posibles costos de impresión y envío.
