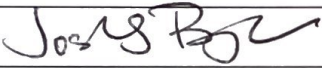

Programa de Conservación de la Audición

(c) General. El empleador debe administrar un programa de conservación de la audición efectivo y continuo, como se describe en esta sección, cada vez que el nivel de exposición de los empleados a los ruidos iguala o supera el nivel de 85 dB de promedio ponderado en un tiempo de 8 horas medido en la escala-A (con respuesta lenta), o equivalentemente, una dosis del cincuenta por ciento. Para los empleados del programa de conservación de la audición, la exposición de los empleados a ruidos deberá ser computada de acuerdo con el Apéndice A y la Tabla A-1 y sin tomar en cuenta a ningún tipo de atenuación provista por el uso de equipos de protección personal.

(d) Monitoreo

(1) Cuando la información indique que la exposición de cualquier empleado iguala o supera 85 decibelios de promedio ponderado en un tiempo de 8 horas, el empleador deberá realizar mediciones para empleados que padecen exposición a ese nivel de ruido o uno superior. Esa determinación deberá estar hecha para el 2 de Diciembre de 1992.

(2) El requisito de monitoreo deberá lagrarse ya sea por un monitoreo del área o un monitoreo personal que sea representativo de la exposición de los empleados.

(A) La categoría de monitoreo deberá ser diseñada con el objeto de identificar a los empleados para su inclusión en el programa de conservación de la audición, y para permitirle adecuada selección de protectores auditivos.

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WATER INDUSTRY PROTECTION ORDER

Sections 4(A) and 10(C) amended January 1, 2021, pursuant to SB 1021, effective January 1, 2021.

This Order Must Be Posted Where Employees Can Read It

Effective January 1, 2021, the following provisions of the Labor Code shall apply to the water industry:

2022 COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave

Effective February 19, 2022

Covered employees in the public or private sector are entitled to up to 40 hours of 2022 COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave (SPSL) for use during the period from September 30, 2021, to September 30, 2022, immediately upon an employee's request for leave.

A full-time covered employee may take up to 5 days of SPSL in 2022.

- **Vaccine-related:** The covered employee or a family member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or the employee or family member is experiencing symptoms or is experiencing a positive COVID-19 test result.
- **Caring for others:** The covered employee is caring for a family member who is experiencing symptoms or is experiencing a positive COVID-19 test result.
- **Quarantine:** The covered employee has been ordered to quarantine by a health official.
