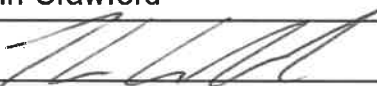

2025 CCR Delivery Methods

1. **Postcard** – Mailed notification postcard to 10,858 customer accounts with direct URL (mnwd.com/ccr) to CCR.
2. **Bill Message** – Provided to all customer accounts on the customer bill; mailed to approximately 40,040 customer accounts who receive a paper bill, and available to view online for approximately 14,745 customer accounts through the July billing Period.
3. **Community E-Newsletter** – Notified 55,373 customers through two separate e-newsletter stories (July) that the CCR is available with a direct URL to the CCR.
4. **Bill Insert (Newsletter Story)** – Mailed to approximately 40,040 customer accounts who receive a paper bill, and available to view on e.bill for approximately 15,189 customer accounts through the July billing period.
5. **Social Media** – Promoted on the District's Nextdoor (85,038 followers), Facebook (2,868 followers), Instagram (558 followers) and Twitter/X (900 followers)
6. **Flyer Posted in Public/Community Locations** – The following notice stating that the CCR is available online was placed at the locations listed below on June 30, 2024, consisting of District offices and other public/community locations.
