

-Include CCR in Inner Circle News.

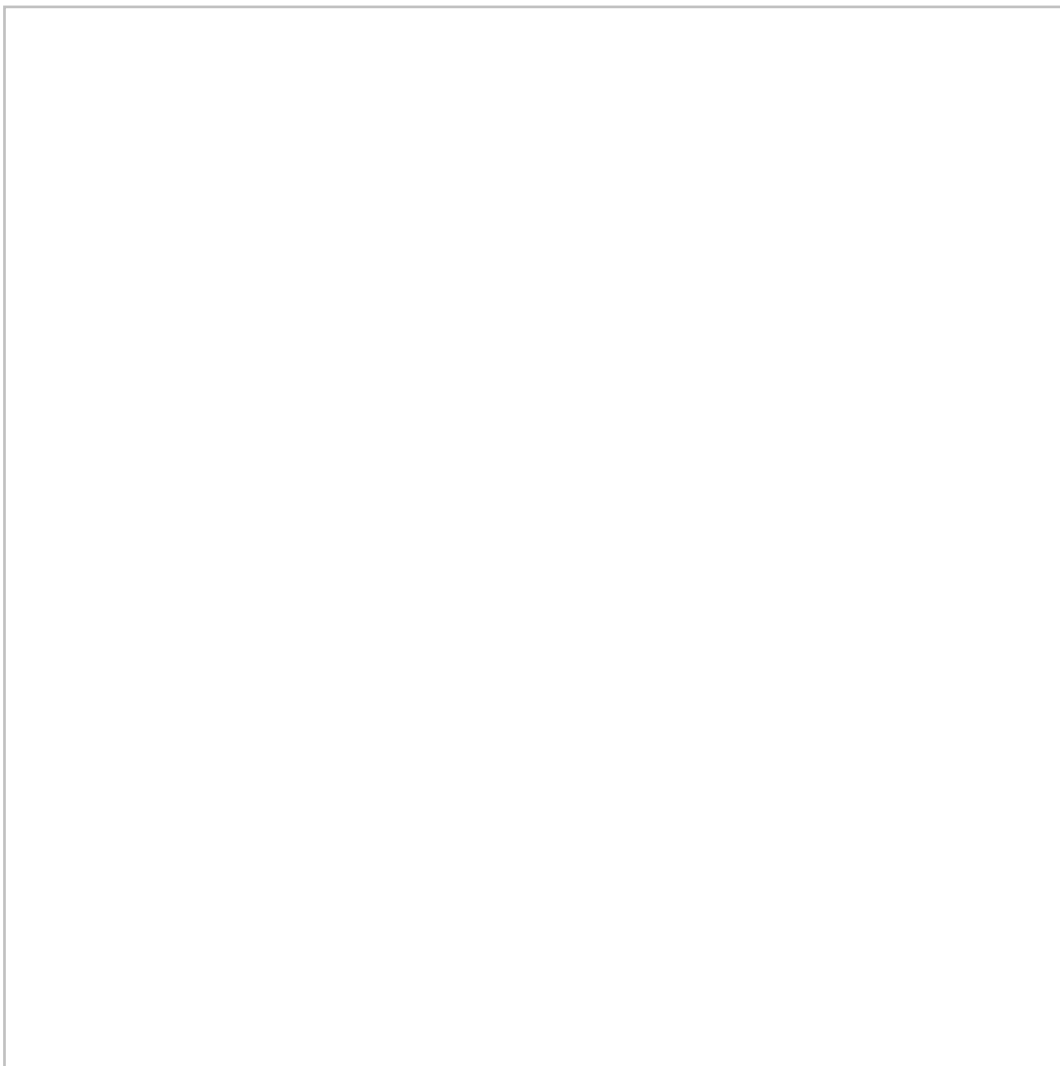
