#### Should Customers be Concerned?

Should Customers be Concerned? Most contaminants are not a significant concern in Fort Irwin water. Some people may be more concerned by concerns in drinking water than the general population. Persons who are pregnant, sick, elderly, or have underlying health conditions may be more concerned.
