



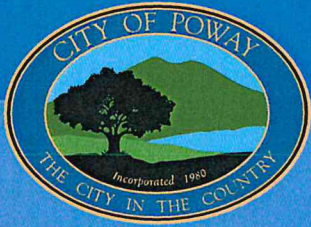

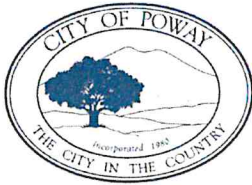

Poway, CA (June 30, 2023) – The City of Poway water customers continue to receive high-quality drinking water as shown in the City's 2022 Annual Water Quality Report released this week. The annual publication is a state and federal requirement that provides test results of water quality analysis conducted in 2022. Also called a Consumer Confidence Report or CCR, the report is intended to educate the public on the extensive monitoring done on its drinking water and the findings of those tests.

The city has posted the 2022 Water Quality Report on its website in lieu of sending copies by postal mail to homes and businesses. The report is available online at poway.org/waterqualityreport2022.

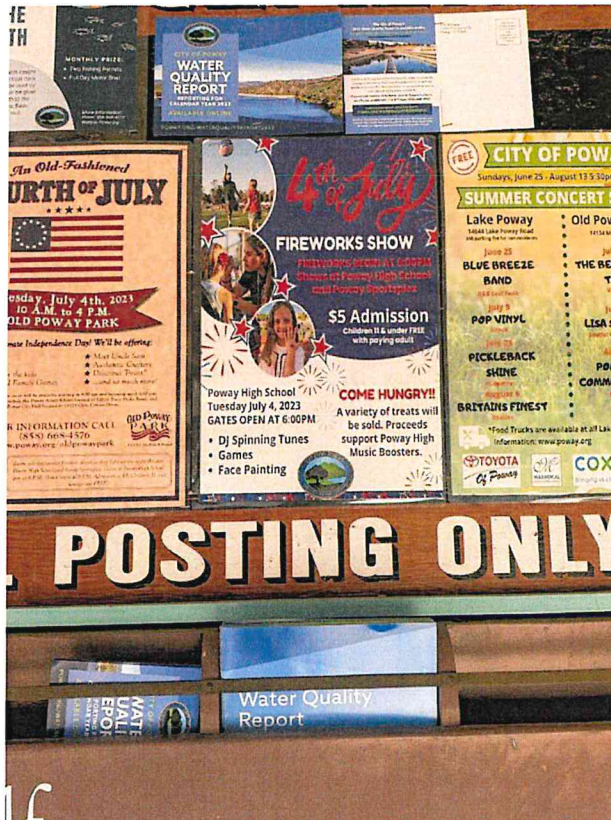

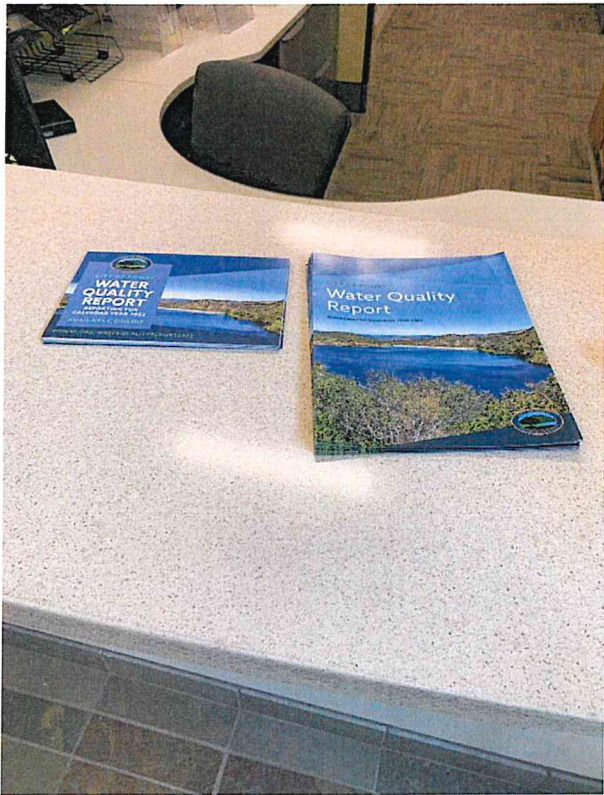

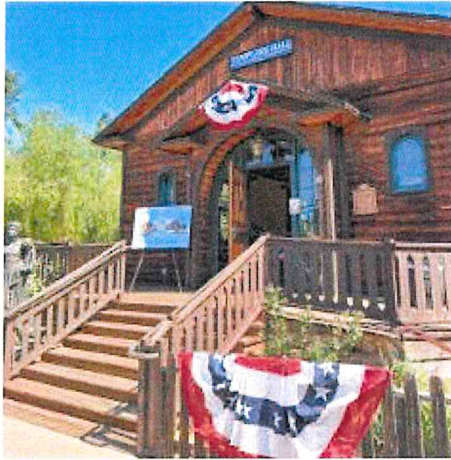
Lake Poway Playground Renovation Begins

Work will require lane closures. Poway maximizes the use of public funds by applying the right treatment at the right time to extend the life of the pavement. This approach maximizes pavement life using available and anticipated funding to keep the city's streets in good condition. The city rotates street repairs, with one of eight street maintenance zones worked on each year.
