Climate credit coming to October bills

Central Coast Community Energy (CCCE) residential customers can expect a state energy credit on their October energy bills, CCCE announced this month.

The credit, known as the California Climate Credit, is funded by the state's Cap-and-Trade Program under the program, utilities and fuel suppliers pay for any greenhouse gas emissions they produce. A portion of the payments are given back to households along the Central Coast through the credit twice a year.

CCCE customers automatically receive the credit; they do not need to apply. "The California Climate Credit helps support families and households in our state while we invest in a sustainable energy transition," said Robert M. Shaw, CEO of Central Coast Community Energy. "This program delivers an important benefit to our customers as CCCE continues to invest in clean energy projects that create jobs, reduce emissions, and improve public health."

Locals push back against Trump administration with "Hold the Line" protest

Carpinteria locals and residents along the California coast plan to protest President Donald J. Trump and his administration on Saturday, Sept. 27, 10 a.m. — noon.

The "Hold the Line" protests are organized by hundreds of individuals, an advisory group. Carpinteria Individual's representative Carol Karvonen said groups from Tule Lake to San Diego will line up along the coast in Carpinteria, protesters will join at the Tule Center — where Linden and Carpinteria avenues meet — before heading back down Carpinteria Avenue towards Tule Avenue.

Local protesters will also hold signs supporting Proposition 53, an amendment opposing an 11th state's Nov. 4 ballot that would redraw congressional district maps in favor of the Democratic Party, Karvonen said.

Proposition 53 — which will temporarily require new congressional district maps through 2030 — was put on the November California ballot in response to congressional redistricting in Texas earlier this year. In Texas, the redistricting would cut up the state into congressional seats for the Republican Party.

"The idea groups (in Los Angeles and Orange County) are organizing hundreds of groups. We've decided on an emphasis on Prop 53," Karvonen said, adding that participants are welcome to bring signs and signs. "At 10 a.m. we're going to stop and hold signs (...) I think it's going to be peaceful."

She said the gathering will allow people to stand up and say, "Yes, I don't like this administration. There's one thing that we can agree on: democracy. We're standing up, we're saying, 'Stand up, join us.'"

Volunteers remove 3.6k pounds of trash from coast

Volunteers across Santa Barbara County removed 3,613 pounds of trash from the coastline on Saturday during the county's Coastal Clean Up Day. Areas 20 sites — including in Carpinteria — over 1,000 volunteers cleaned up 28 miles of coastline on Sept. 25, according to preliminary results released by organizer Debrae DeLong over the weekend.

The most commonly found items were plastic pieces, cigarette butts and food wrappers, Debrae DeLong representative said. Volunteers also found a metal can, a pink knitted skirt, and a mattress.

Volunteer Madison Hoffmeyer found the day's "treasure chest" — taking home a gift card for a two-night stay at Cayana Beaches Resort.

"This year's Coastal Cleanup Day was such a pilgrimage for the town of our spirit and it is so special a community," said Lisa White, coastal cleanup day coordinator. "It was amazing to see so many people coming together to clean up our beautiful coastline! This event has an incredible history, and there have been great stories can change how we collectively treat the planet."
