On June 16, 2023, the 2022 CCR URL was sent via email to customers within our billing system (2,151 accounts of 2,731 total active domestic and agricultural accounts). Customers who have not provided the District with an email address (580 total) were mailed a hard copy notice. Each water bill sent for the month of June included the CCR URL and a message regarding the availability of the report. The message included the notification that a copy of the report would be emailed or mailed upon request. Hard copies are available at the District's Office and were posted at the Solvang Public Library and the Office entrance bulletin board. Attached are sample copies of a June utility bill, email announcement, mail announcement, and the District's 2022 CCR. The 2022 CCR was uploaded to the District's web site on June 30, 2023.
