The City of Ceres Public Works Department included notification of availability of the 2024 CCR in the May 10, 2025 paper billing, informing customers that the CCR would be available online as of July 1, 2025 with a QR code and website URL to view/download the document and contact information to request paper copies; this included electronic delivery via email to almost 3,400 paperless and online bill pay customers. A newspaper ad informing the public of upcoming 2024 CCR availability ran in the Ceres Courier on May 28, 2025.

On June 30, 2025 the 2024 CCR was posted to the website URL referenced on page 1 and paper copies were displayed at the following public places: City Hall, Public Works Administration, Community Center.


