Dear Middle Road Mutual Customer:

This letter is a supplement to the City of Santa Paula Consumer Confidence Report (annual water quality report) that was mailed to you on July 1 2019. This report covers all sampling and analyses performed on source water during calendar year 2018. Because Middle Road Mutual Water Company (MRMWC) receives all of its water from the City of Santa Paula water system through two master meters' the results shown on the report, accurately represent the quality of the MRMWC source water.

In addition to City source water sampling and analysis, City Staff also took distribution samples from the MRMWC distribution system at two dedicated sampling stations: one on Foothill Road and one on Santa Paula Street.

- Twenty-four samples were tested for the presence of coliform bacteria, and all were found to be negative.
- Twelve samples were tested for color, odor, and turbidity, and all were found to be within acceptable limits.


