Camarillo Continues to Deliver Clean and Safe Water to Customers

Camarillo, CA – The City of Camarillo's Annual Water Quality Report for 2024 confirms that Camarillo continues its long-standing tradition of delivering clean, safe, and reliable drinking water to all residents and businesses within the City's water service area. The full report is posted on the City's website at cityofcamarillo.org/waterquality.

Exceeding Standards: The results of the Annual Water Quality Report show that all detected substances in Camarillo's water service area were below their respective maximum allowed levels in 2024. The North Pleasant Valley Desalter has significantly improved water quality in portions of the city by reducing mineral content and improving overall water clarity. This landmark treatment facility is a testament to our commitment to providing the highest quality water to ensure the health and well-being of the Camarillo community.

Regulatory Framework: To ensure that tap water is safe to drink, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB) prescribe regulations that strictly limit the amount of contaminants in water provided by public water systems. The SWRCB's Division of Drinking Water requires all public water systems to certify a consumer confidence report annually to document the results of water quality testing.

Continual Monitoring: Camarillo's water is monitored regularly to assess the presence of various substances. Our testing aligns with EPA guidelines, ensuring that the water meets all health and safety standards. The annual report details all water quality testing performed between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024, disclosing any substances that were detected in our water. It is important to note that detecting a substance does not mean that water is unsafe to drink. The City aims to keep all detected substances below their respective maximum allowed levels.

Report Availability: The full report is available to the public starting July 1, 2025, on the City of Camarillo's website at cityofcamarillo.org/waterquality. Printed copies of the report are available upon request at City Hall (601 Carmen Drive, Camarillo), or one can be mailed to you by calling the City's Water Division at (805) 388-5373.

Water Quality Awareness: The City encourages schools, landlords, business owners, and others to share the report with students, tenants, employees, and other water users.

NOTICE! You have been sued. The court may decide against you without your being heard unless you respond within 30 days. Read the information below. You have 30 CALENDAR DAYS after this summons and legal papers are served on you to file a written response at this court and have a copy served on the plaintiff. A letter or phone call will not protect you. Your written response must be in proper legal form if you want the court to hear your case. There may be a court form that you can use for your response. You can find these court forms and more information at the California Courts Online Self-Help Center (www.courtinfo.ca.gov/selfhelp), your county law library, or the courthouse nearest you. If you cannot pay the filing fee, ask the court clerk for a fee waiver form. If you do not file your response on time, you may lose the case by default, and your wages, money, and property may be taken without further warning from the court. There are other legal requirements. You may want to call an attorney right away. If you do not know an attorney, you may want to call an attorney referral service. If you cannot afford an attorney, you may be eligible for free legal services from a nonprofit legal services program. You can locate these nonprofit groups at the California Legal Services Web site (www.lawhelpcalifornia.org), the California Courts Online Self-Help Center (www.courtinfo.ca.gov/selfhelp), or by contacting your local court or county bar association. **NOTE:** The court has a statutory lien for waived fees and costs on any settlement or arbitration award of \$10,000 or more in a civil case.
