



The Ventura County Waterworks District No. 8, serving more than 26,000 homes and businesses within the City of Simi Valley, has published the Annual Water Quality Report (WQR). The Report is available at www.simivalley.org/WQR. The Report provides information regarding drinking water quality over the past calendar year (2019), in conformance with U.S. EPA and State Water Resources Control Board standards.
